### Nature of client business

Dickleburgh Stores is based in rural Norfolk. They have been trading for over 100 years. It is the closest and most convenient store for residents with the next nearest store for the village over six miles away. There is also a post office in store.

### Scope of job

Adcock was appointed to install a new Daikin ZEAS Inverter Condensing unit and LT booster. The new Dickleburgh Store owner Mike Humphreys, who took over the store in 2015, was planning a renovation of the store. The renovation plans included energy efficient, low-noise refrigeration technology.

### What the project entailed

The store wanted to have the ZEAS system installed because of the design for high efficiency and low operating costs.

The installation fitted in to a tight renovation programme to minimise disruption of trading and inconvenience for customers. It was also important to ensure that the new installation would not disturb the neighbours as the store is close to some residential properties.
