Scope of project

The City Road premises are the 5th premises the client has opened and our scope of works was to design and install air conditioning and ventilation systems to serve them. Upon completion, Adcock Refrigeration and Air Conditioning will then continue to provide planned and reactive maintenance on the new systems under a contract which covers all the clients sites.

What the Project entailed

The design brief was for the systems to give the 'on trend' industrial feel to the space. This is achieved by the air conditioning units and ductwork for both the air conditioning and the ventilation being exposed in the occupied space.

The air conditioning will provide both cooling and heating. The heating is supplementary and is provided by the fact the air conditioning systems are air to air heat pump type systems.

This form of heating is an energy efficient form of heating with COP's of circa 3.75 :1. They also have the advantage of providing cooling when required.

The space for the externally sited condensing units was limited and so systems from the Mitsubishi Heavy Industries KX6- M (mini) series of VRF (Variable Refrigerant Flow) systems were selected.

What we brought to the job

Adcock have worked with the architect for around 20 years and the end user for over 13 years.

In addition Adcock service and maintain all site systems through an ongoing service and maintenance contract.

We were selected to carry out this work due to our knowledge and experience of working on design concepts which have a high visual impact and where a meticulous attention to detail is required.
