### Nature of client business

The William Hill chain of bookmakers was founded in 1934 and since then it has become one of the most trusted and respected brands in the world.

William Hill Bookmakers have a large network of betting shops that offer a variety of high quality gaming and betting services including over the counter and self-service betting terminals.

**Project Location:** The Headrow, Leeds.

### Scope of job

Adcock was appointed to supply and install a new Hitachi centrifugal air conditioning system and mechanical ventilation to replace their outdated system which contained R22 refrigerant. The new system needed to be replaced during normal opening hours.

### What the project entailed

The William Hill shop is centrally located in Leeds. This busy bookmaker's trades from 8.30am 10.00pm which meant that the installation needed to take place during opening hours and with the minimum of disruption.

Due to its central location there was no outside area to position the outdoor condensing units therefore a 178kg Hitachi centrifugal unit was installed in the ceiling void and ducted to an outside wall for ventilation.

The works also included installation of an electrical mains distribution board.
